



# Wellness and Vaccination Clinic Community Outreach Project

On behalf of KAR and Dr. Kathleen Corbett, DVM, we are proud to announce wellness and vaccination clinics to service your canine and feline family members during this challenging time. These clinics are aimed to provide physical examinations, vaccinations for puppy/adult dogs and kitten/adult cats, annual heartworm and tick-borne blood testing, and Feline Leukemia/FIV testing as well as microchipping, rabies certification, and written prescriptions for preventative heartworm and flea/tick medications.

## WHAT?

Unfortunately, we are **NOT** able to perform nail trims, anal gland expressions, or other grooming needs currently, and recommend a professional groomer for these services.

These clinics are **NOT** aimed for long-term veterinary care. We recommend clients continue to pursue a valid client/patient relationship with a local veterinary clinic/hospital for future companion animal care.
